PRODUCT DESCRIPTION

Universal, elastic, instantly water- and airtight tape for (emergency) repairs. Also fo use in combination with HBS-200° Liquid Rubber.

FIELD OF APPLICATION

Suitable for for (emergency) repairs. Also for use in combination with HBS-200° Liquid Rubber in big seam, crack and tear-bridging applications and for building up layer thickness.

PREPARATION

Working conditions: Only apply at temperatures above $+5^{\circ}$ C.

Surface requirements: Surfaces must be as dry as possible, clean and free of dust and grease. Because of the versatility of materials and conditions, it is recommended to do an adhesion test in advance.

Preliminary surface treatment: Surfaces must be as dry as possible, clean and free of dust and grease. Because of the versatility of materials and conditions, it is recommended to do an adhesion test in advance.

APPLICATION

Directions for use:

- 1) Remove the protective film from the tape.
- 2) Apply the tape to the surface. Overlap if application is wider/broader than the tape.

In case the tape is exposed to (heavy) weather conditions, the tape can be covered with HBS-200° Liquid Rubber (as soon as weather conditions permit) for a permanent solution.
